



## Fountain Grass, Burgundy Bunny Dwarf

*Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Burgundy Bunny'*

### Description:

A fine textured dwarf fountain grass suitable for smaller areas; green foliage develops striking red tips, and matures to burgundy in fall; blooms are large bottle brush like cream plumes that persist until winter; great in patio containers or rock garden

### Ornamental Features

Fountain Grass, Burgundy Bunny Dwarf has masses of beautiful plumes of creamy white flowers rising above the foliage in mid summer, which are most effective when planted in groupings. Its grassy leaves are green in color with prominent dark red tips. As an added bonus, the foliage turns a gorgeous burgundy in the fall.

### Landscape Attributes

Fountain Grass, Burgundy Bunny Dwarf is an herbaceous perennial grass with a shapely form and gracefully arching stems. It brings an extremely fine and delicate texture to the garden composition and should be used to full effect.

This is a relatively low maintenance plant, and is best cleaned up in early spring before it resumes active growth for the season. Deer don't particularly care for this plant and will usually leave it alone in favor of tastier treats. It has no significant negative characteristics.

### **Planting & Growing**

Fountain Grass, Burgundy Bunny Dwarf will grow to be about 14 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 16 inches. It grows at a medium rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 10 years. As an herbaceous perennial, this plant will usually die back to the crown each winter, and will regrow from the base each spring. Be careful not to disturb the crown in late winter when it may not be readily seen!

This plant does best in full sun to partial shade. It does best in average to evenly moist conditions, but will not tolerate standing water. To help this plant achieve its best flowering performance, periodically apply a flower-boosting fertilizer from early spring through into the active growing season. It is not particular as to soil type or pH, and is able to handle environmental salt. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. This is a selected variety of a species not originally from North America. It can be propagated by division; however, as a cultivated variety, be aware that it may be subject to certain restrictions or prohibitions on propagation.

Fountain Grass, Burgundy Bunny Dwarf is a fine choice for the garden, but it is also a good selection for planting in outdoor pots and containers. It is often used as a 'filler' in the 'spiller-thriller-filler' container combination, providing a mass of flowers against which the thriller plants stand out. Note that when growing plants in outdoor containers and baskets, they may require more frequent waterings than they would in the yard or garden.
