



## **Agastache, Beelicious Pink Hummingbird Mint**

### **Description:**

An easy-to-care for, upright and well branched selection featuring spikes of vibrant light-pink flowers with burgundy calyces; a favorite for native butterflies and hummingbirds; soothing, aromatic, licorice scented foliage for the fragrant garden

### **Ornamental Features**

Agastache, Beelicious Pink Hummingbird Mint features airy spikes of lightly-scented shell pink tubular flowers with burgundy calyces rising above the foliage from mid summer to early fall. The flowers are excellent for cutting. Its attractive fragrant pointy leaves remain grayish green in color with distinctive dark green veins throughout the season.

### **Landscape Attributes**

Agastache, Beelicious Pink Hummingbird Mint is an open herbaceous perennial with an upright spreading habit of growth. Its relatively fine texture sets it apart from other garden plants with less refined foliage.

This is a relatively low maintenance plant, and is best cleaned up in early spring before it resumes active growth for the season. It is a good choice for attracting bees, butterflies and hummingbirds to your yard, but is not particularly attractive to deer who tend to leave it alone in favor of tastier treats. It has no significant negative characteristics.

- Mass Planting
- General Garden Use
- Naturalizing And Woodland Gardens
- Herb Gardens
- Container Planting

### **Planting & Growing**

Agastache, Beelicious Pink Hummingbird Mint will grow to be about 12 inches tall at maturity extending to 16 inches tall with the flowers, with a spread of 12 inches. It grows at a fast rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 6 years. As an herbaceous perennial, this plant will usually die back to the crown each winter, and will regrow from the base each spring. Be careful not to disturb the crown in late winter when it may not be readily seen!

This plant does best in full sun to partial shade. It does best in average conditions that are neither too wet nor too dry, and is very intolerant of standing water. To help this plant achieve its best flowering performance, periodically apply a flower-boosting fertilizer from early spring through into the active growing season. It is not particular as to soil type, but has a definite preference for alkaline soils, and is able to handle environmental salt. It is somewhat tolerant of urban pollution. This particular variety is an interspecific hybrid. It can be propagated by division; however, as a cultivated variety, be aware that it may be subject to certain restrictions or prohibitions on propagation.

Agastache, Beelicious Pink Hummingbird Mint is a fine choice for the garden, but it is also a good selection for planting in outdoor pots and containers. It is often used as a 'filler' in the 'spiller-thriller-filler' container combination, providing a mass of flowers and foliage against which the larger thriller plants stand out. Note that when growing plants in outdoor containers and baskets, they may require more frequent waterings than they would in the yard or garden.
